

RECOMMENDED AUSTRALIAN ITINERARY

All Around Australia 12 day Private Jet Tour.

Day 1-Sydney-Gold Coast

Arrival at Sydney International Airport.

Meet and greet by the private guide. Transfer to the Private jet lounge area.

Gold Coast Departure. (1 hour flight)

Arrival at Brisbane airport. Transfer to your hotel: Palazzo Versace Hotel 5*.

Day 2-Gold Coast

Breakfast.

Relaxation and free time on the Gold Coast. Your guide will make sure a vehicle is available for you from 10 am to 10 pm.

Night at the Versace Hotel.

Day 3-Gold Coast

Breakfast.

Your day to relax and unwind.

You may pay a visit to one of several Theme Parks if you are travelling with children. It is only 20-40 minutes away from your Hotel.

Alternatively, you can choose a heli-scenic flight along the coast, tour to a winery or a visit to a Glowworm cave.

There is always a possibility of going to the world-renowned Surfers Paradise, whether you going to surf yourself or not.

Day 4-Gold Coast Hot Air Ballooning

Very early continental breakfast.

4:30am departure from the Hotel for the experience of your life: Hot Air Ballooning.

If you wish and following the strict instructions from the Team, you can set up the Hot Air balloon before your flight; one hour later you land at a Vineyard for a delicious hot breakfast with champagne!

The return to your hotel is around 11 AM.

The rest of the day is at your leisure.

Day 5-Gold Coast-Hamilton Island-Hayman Island

Breakfast.

Transfer to the Airport followed by a short flight to Hamilton Island (1.5 hours), by private plane.

Upon your arrival, it's a short walk to the Helicopter that will transfer you to Hayman Island (30 mins flight).

Hayman Island is a premier Island resort and if you are looking for unrivalled luxury AND a tropical paradise then look no further.

Situated within the Great Barrier Reef, the Island is about 20Km from Airlie Beach and with tropical latitude of 20 degrees south is the most northerly of the 70 plus islands in Queensland's Whitsunday Island Group.

The helicopters range from a Longranger to a Robinson 44. They can be used for transferring your luggage or alternatively, your luggage can be transferred by ferry.

Meet and greet by the staff of Hayman hotel. 2 minute transfer from the Helipad to the Hotel.

If you are booked into the Penthouse, your private butler, who will be your helper and advisor for the whole time on the Island, will meet with you at this time.

Day 6-Private Yacht-Hayman Island

After breakfast,

Your private yacht charter awaits.

Today, you will experience the best of relaxation on water: chartering around the Reef, sun bathing, swimming, diving and enjoying a sumptuous BBQ on board.

Arrival back to hotel closer toward dinnertime.

Day 7-Hayman Island

Breakfast.

Day of Relaxation on Hayman Island.

Day 8-Adelaide-Kangaroo Island

Breakfast.

Half an hour helicopter flight back to Hamilton Island in order to leave for Adelaide followed by 3.5 hours of flying in your private charter plane.

Arrival at Adelaide airport about 4:30 PM, or earlier.

Helicopter pick up at the airport and then a picturesque heli transfer to Kangaroo Island.

Kangaroo Island

Southwest of Adelaide, separated from the Australian mainland by Backstairs Passage is Kangaroo Island. Kangaroo Island is just 16 kilometres off the tip of the Fleurieu Peninsula and possesses 480 kilometres of coastline.

Europeans discovered the island in 1802. English explorer Matthew Flinders was first to see the island followed shortly by French explorer Nicolas Baudin.

Unspoilt wilderness.

Kangaroo Island is a genuinely unique region with more than one third of the entire Island dedicated to national and wildlife parks. The area is totally protected from the

mainland and, in many areas, the impact of human activity has been minimal. The pure air and clean water makes Kangaroo Island one of the last unspoilt regions of the world and visitors embrace the natural beauty and pristine environment.

For intrepid sightseers, there is an abundance of native wildlife and vegetation. Visitors can expect to see playful fur seals, Australian sea lions, penguins, koalas, wallabies, goannas, up to 251 types of bird and, of course the island's namesake kangaroos.

Helicopters arrive at helipads of Southern Ocean Lodge.

Day 9-Kangaroo Island

Breakfast.

Private 4 WD tour of the Island, with picnic.

Today you will visit: Small Sahara, Admiral's Arch, National Park Flinders Chase.. You will see koala, sea lions, wallabies, kangaroo, goannas and emu.

The nature "architecture" here is something between Salvador Dali and Henri Moore..

Night at Southern Ocean Lodge.

Day 10-Kangaroo Island-Sydney

After breakfast, helicopter departure back to Adelaide.

Private flight to Sydney.

Meet and greet at the Airport, transfer in the private vehicle to the 4 Seasons Hotel.

Check into 4 Seasons hotel.

Night in Sydney.

Day 11–Sydney-Blue Mountains

Breakfast.

We suggest spending the first part of the day viewing Sydney from the air in a one-hour flight.

You might wish to spend the second half of the day, exploring the Cities Northern beaches, Manley and Palm Beach for example.

OR, instead of all of the above, we can organise a Helicopter tour to the Blue Mountains – a truly remarkable experience.

The Blue Mountains National Park, about 120 km west of Sydney by road, is a scenically dramatic region of forested ravines and pristine bushland. It is part of the Greater Blue Mountains World Heritage Area and listed for its extensive eucalypt forests and natural biodiversity.

The Wollemi Pine, the world's oldest species of tree found in Wollemi National Park, is unique to the Blue Mountains. The region is so densely forested the 40-metre-high trees escaped detection until 1994, flourishing undisturbed in a remote valley less than 200 km from Sydney.

Well-marked walking trails criss-cross Blue Mountains National Park, passing streams and waterfalls, descending into cool gorges and snaking around sheer cliffs where views are endless and dimensions enormous. The NSW National Parks and Wildlife Service conducts walks, as do specialist eco-tour operators.

The region's best-known rock formation is The Three Sisters, a trio of pinnacles best viewed from Katoomba, the largest of 26 mountain towns and villages. These include Wentworth Falls (near a beautiful waterfall of the same name), Faulconbridge and Katoomba.

You might wish to organise a special dinner tonight.

Night in Sydney.

Day 12–Sydney -Departure

Breakfast.
