

SUGGESTED TAHITI YACHTING PROGRAMME

Day 1 - Bora Bora

In the morning, champagne and fresh fruits greet guests at the Bora Bora airport before private transfer to the **Ti'a Moana** super-yacht. Dress for breakfast buffet on the Uporu deck. Later, lunch aboard while navigating in the colourful lagoon of Bora Bora.

Afternoon on the Motu. Towels, chairs, pillows, snorkeling material and kayaks are at guest's disposal. **Nomade Spa** face and body cares directly on the beach of the Motu (additional fee).

Refreshments and afternoon tea served both aboard and on the Motu, followed by dinner onboard and navigation towards the island of Taha'a, (approximately two hours in the open sea).

Day 2 - Taha'a

In the morning visit a Coral garden. Scuba diving, wave running, or island discovery on a four wheel drive excursion (additional fee for these activities).

In the afternoon, entertainment aboard with tattoo specialist: Tavita. Champagne Sunset cruise around the island along the shoreline. Dinner aboard, followed by a fishing party from our platform on Tumama, the aft deck.

Day 3 – Huahine

Arrival in Huahine at dawn. Visit Fare, the island's main village, on foot or by bicycle, followed by lunch aboard while navigating towards Vaiorea to anchor in the bay of Bourayne.

In the afternoon, water activities escorted by activities director. Activities include: to tour a Motu by kayak or while snorkeling, wave runners or Jeep safari may be arranged at additional cost.

Day 4 – Huahine

In the morning cruise in the bay and set anchor in front of the mystic and beautiful site of "Hana Iti". Towels, chairs, pillows, snorkeling equipment and kayaks are at guest's disposal. **Nomade Spa** face and body care available on the beach of the Motu (additional fee).

In the afternoon, refreshments and afternoon tea are served onboard and on the beach. Moonlight dinner on the beach.

Day 5 – Raiatea

In the morning, arrive in Raiatea from Huahine after 2 hours of open sea navigation. Visit Uturoa, the small capital of the Leeward Islands.

Depart at 11 hundred hours and navigate the beautiful wild coast of Raiatea, dropping anchor in front of the district of Fetuna for a walk in the heart of the lush tropical part of the island. Sail to motu Nao Nao for the sunset.

Day 6 – Raiatea

Champagne breakfast served on the beach of the Motu Nao Nao. **Nomade Spa** face and body care on the beach of the Motu (additional). Kayak or snorkeling expedition along the reef.

In the afternoon navigate to OPOA. Visit a Vanilla plantation followed by the sacred site of the Marae Taputapuatea. Navigate to Uturoa where, at dusk, a Tahitian music and dance group will request the pleasure of your company.

Day 7 - Bora Bora

Early morning arrival in Bora Bora to stop in front of the Motu Toopua, home of the Polynesian God Hiro. Tenders are at guest disposal for transfers to Vaitape, the Bora Bora main village.

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
